- Abandoning the Dharma. ("Kings vow")
- Disrobing monks or nuns. ("Kings vow")
- Committing the five heinous crimes. ("Kings vow")
- Holding wrong views.
- Destroying towns and so on. ("Kings vow")
- Teaching emptiness to the untrained. ("Minister vow")
- Reversing others' aspiration for complete enlightenment.
- Causing someone to abandon individual liberation.
- Denigrating the Hinayana.
- Falsely claiming to have realized emptiness.
- Receiving the property of the Three Jewels.
- The person practicing concentration giving his belongings to others.
- Giving up bodhicitta.
